1912 Dec 19 Minnie Staples to Nannie Shelton, Campbellsburg, Henry County, KY. "Hello Cousin. I will try and answer your card. Well, I will be there on Sunday if it ain't raining. You be sure to meet me, for I don't know where you live. From Minnie Staples to Cousin Nannie. Good-bye." [This transcript is not verbatim as the original card contains a number of misspellings and no punctuation.]

East Side, Fifth Street Bridge (Chatham, Ontario, Canada) postcard

1952 Aug 13 Elane (?) and Billy to Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Shelton, Shelbyville, KY. "Dear Folks, We are enjoying the day up in Canada, had lunch and driving back soon to Detroit. Love, Elane & Billy."

El Capitan Peak (NM) postcard

1953 Esse (?) to Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Shelton, Shelbyville, KY. "Monday 10:00. Dear Folks, We are really seeing some wonderful things. Mexico & Texas are lovely. Staying at the La Caverna Hotel tonite in Mexico - Hello to Billy & all - Love Esse."

Beautiful Double Lane Boulevard Along the Gulf Coast (ME) postcard

1957 Jul 23 E. to Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Shelton, Shelbyville, KY. "Dear Folks, This is a wonderful place to be - would like to live here - plan to go to New Orleans tomorrow or Wednesday for the day - coming up to see you when I get home. Hope all are well. Love, E."
